



## Disclaimer/ Rental Agreement Terms & Conditions

1. A responsible person over 18 years of age must supervise the inflatable cube at all times.
2. There is a nonrefundable 20% surcharge for cancellations, regardless of cause, unless you rebook for a date within three months of the cancellation date.
3. WARNING – FLASHING LIGHTS – POTENTIAL ADVERSE HEATH REACTIONS POSSIBLE FOR PEOPLE SUFFERING WITH EPILEPSY AND SIMILAR DISORDERS.
4. WARNING – SMOKE MACHINES - POTENTIAL ADVERSE HEATH REACTIONS POSSIBLE FOR PEOPLE SUFFERING WITH RESPIRATORY PROBLEMS.
5. The equipment hired must be supervised the customer. You are solely liable for any damage to the cube or equipment or any missing equipment whilst in your custody.
6. The inflatable(s) must be secured to the ground at all times with pegs or sandbags provided.
7. The equipment must not be moved or re-positioned.
8. Ensure that the equipment is not overcrowded and limited to the maximum capacity of 35.
9. Do not allow any hard or sharp objects that could damage the equipment.
10. Do not allow anything large enough to block exit/entrance.
11. No animals near the cube or equipment. If you have animals, then ensure that there is no faecal matter on the ground **before** we attend your property.
12. No party-poppers, henna, face paint, coloured streamers or “silly string” can be used near or on the equipment, as these may permanently stain the unit, for which you are liable.
13. No water or other liquid to be poured or sprayed onto the equipment as it could cause damage the surface of inflatables.
14. Inflatables must not be used in wind or wind gusts in excess of 24mph/ 38kph.
15. Inflatables must not be used in heavy rain.

16. Equipment must not be used in thunderstorms.
17. No smoking, barbecues, or glass on or near the equipment.
18. Reckless or boisterous behaviour must not be allowed.
19. Ensure equipment remains where they were positioned during installation.
20. At the end of the hire, it is your responsibility to remove all of your equipment and items from the cube and in the immediate vicinity, including any rubbish which may cause damage to the cube when it is deflated.
21. Ensure that the vent on the side of the blower is kept clear at all times.
22. Should a blower overheat or lose power, immediately remove people from the inflatable and switch the blower off at the mains. It should restart when switched back on again 1 or 2 minutes later. If not then please inform us on the telephone number above.
23. We must be advised as soon as possible in the event of any injury requiring professional medical treatment. Treatment must be sought within 2 hours of the injury occurring and a detailed record of the incident and treatment must be provided to us.
24. You must call us immediately upon any equipment failure. If you are unsure about anything, please contact us immediately.

## ***Disclaimer / Rental Agreement Form - Safety Checklist***

- Setup area must be clear of debris and/or sharp objects
- Inflatable(s) are stable and on level ground.
- Inflatable(s) have been suitably anchored to the ground.
- Blower(s) are securely attached & a safe distance from the equipment.
- Electrical cords are in good working order.
- There are no visible tears, rips or seams to the inflatable.
- Equipment left fully inflated and in working order.
- Hire agreement & safety instructions read and signed by customer.
